### **Note .**

The University of Cincinnati Board of Trustees prohibits guarantees of support for more than one year. However, to date, the department has never failed to support students for at least five years assuming that they make adequate progress at all times. All entering students receive full tuition remission as well as a stipend. The graduate scholarship covers all university/institution fees, except for the instructional technology fee (\$184 per semester). Students must carry health insurance from the university (covered at 100%) or from an outside provider.
