- **Length:** To be considered, manuscripts length must be between 7,000 and 8,000 words.
- **Citation Style:** Use MLA for references.

- **Language:** Spanish or English.
- **Submission Deadline for Manuscripts:** **JANUARY 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2025**

All submissions will undergo a review process. We encourage original research, critical essays, and interdisciplinary approaches that contribute to a deeper understanding of the subject.
